




Emily has 6 pennies, and she pays 4 cents for a sticker. How much change would she get back?

Question 6

Oliver has 5 nickels and 7 pennies. After he spends 22 cents, how much money does he have?

Question 7

Olivia has 35 cents, and her uncle gives her 2 quarters. How much money does Olivia have?

Question 8

If John has 42 cents and finds 1 quarter and 2 pennies, how much money does he have now?

Question 9

Grace has 3 dimes and 2 nickels. Olivia has 20 pennies. After Olivia uses 5 pennies to buy a lollipop, who has less money?

Question 10

Bob had 22 cents, but he gave a dime to his sister. How much money does he have left?
